TERMS OF REFERENCE - WYCNA SUB-COMMITTEE (LEAGUE)

1. The Sub-Committee will be known as the League Committee.
2. The League Committee will be responsible for the management and administration of the WYCNA League which will include:
 - 2.1. League entries;
 - 2.2. Organisation of fixtures and venues;
 - 2.3. Publication of the League Handbook;
 - 2.4. Collating and publishing results;
 - 2.5. Dealing with correspondence relating to the League;
 - 2.6. Dealing with league complaints and grievances:
 - 2.6.1. Any complaint or grievance is to be dealt with by the appointed officer(s) or Committee, as deemed appropriate for a decision;
 - 2.6.2. Following any appeal against a decision referred to under 2.6.1, the League Committee will pass the appeal to the Investigation Committee to investigate and make recommendations back to the League Committee who will either confirm or rescind their original decision.
 - 2.6.3. Any further appeal will be passed to the County Appeals Committee for a final decision to be made.
3. The League Committee will consist of a Chairman, Vice-Chairman, League Secretary, Minutes Secretary, Treasurer, Fixtures Secretary, Results Secretaries and one Ordinary Member plus a representative from the County Committee. **N.B.** *The League Committee shall have the right to co-opt additional members as necessary.*
4. The voting procedure will be as follows:
 - 5.1. A simple majority vote is required to pass any motion;
 - 5.2. With the exception of the Chairman each member is entitled to one vote;
 - 5.3. The Chairman shall have only one vote which may only be used in the event of an equality of votes.
5. The League Committee will liaise with the WYCNA County Committee as specified in the role descriptions.
6. The League Committee will liaise with the appropriate County Officers with regard to umpiring and coaching requirements, e.g. courses, tests.
7. The League Committee will be responsible for the organisation of the League AGM:
 - 8.1. The League Chairman will preside;
 - 8.2. All teams in the membership of the League are entitled to one vote;
 - 8.3. The Chairman shall have only one vote, which may only be used in the event of an equality of votes.
8. Any matter not covered by the above should be referred to the County Committee.
9. In the event of the dissolution of the League Committee, any assets remaining after discharging all debts and liabilities shall be absorbed by the County Committee.

ADVISORY NOTES

These notes do not constitute rules in their own right but will be used by the League as guidance should the need arise.

The League Committee should each year have the power to appoint an Investigation Committee composed of not less than 3 League members and may include at least one person who is not a member of the League Committee.

No member of investigation, disciplinary or appeal committee should have any direct knowledge of the alleged incident, nor in any way related to the parties concerned, nor be members of the same club. They must be completely independent. The Disciplinary Committee might include a County Official. If a member is not completely independent of a complaint they must not be involved at any stage and an appropriate substitute may be appointed.

INVESTIGATION

Complaints should be put in writing to 2 members of the League Committee within 14 days of the alleged incident, clearly stating that it is to be treated as an official complaint.

On receiving a complaint, it shall be the duty of the Secretary to inform the League's appointed Investigation Committee.

The League Investigation Committee shall have the power to call for such information as it requires to enable it to decide if there is a case to be heard. Before making a decision, the Investigation Committee shall make sure that the member and/or club 'accused' is sent written notice of the alleged infringement and shall ensure that they are given an opportunity to make written representation of the facts.

The League Investigation Committee may also decide to give the member or club the opportunity to be heard personally but this is left to the absolute discretion of the Investigation Committee.

The League Investigation Committee will maintain records of its investigations and produce a written report of its findings.

DISCIPLINARY

If there appears to be a bona fide case to be answered of a disciplinary nature then the matter will be referred to the County disciplinary secretary.

APPEAL COMMITTEE

1. The Appeal Committee should consist of 3 or 5 independent people with no previous direct knowledge of the incident and must include at least one County Committee member. (Personnel from other Leagues or from the County Association should be approached).
2. An appeal hearing shall be arranged and the 'accused' shall be given the opportunity to be heard.
3. If the 'accused' does not attend and the Appeal Committee is satisfied that the notice of the hearing was received by the 'accused' the Appeal may proceed in his/her absence.
4. The Appeal Committee should consider the record of evidence and, if it thinks fit, receive fresh evidence.
5. The Appeal Committee may affirm, rescind or vary any penalty previously imposed by the Disciplinary Committee.
6. The Appeal Committee shall inform the League of the decision as soon as possible. The League shall inform the 'accused'.
7. The decision of the Appeal Committee shall be final and binding on all parties.

RECORDS

Records must be maintained of:

- Complaint against the individual
- The individuals response
- The findings made and actions taken
- Details of any appeal
- Outcome of the appeal
- Any correspondence received and sent



LEAGUE RULES

1. a) The West Yorkshire League games will be run in accordance with the International Netball Federation (INF) Rules of Netball.
- b) All West Yorkshire League fixtures will be played at approved venues. All fixtures will be played indoors.
- c) If the League finds it necessary to cancel or alter the venue for one or more of the matches at an approved venue, it will ensure that any remaining teams at the original venue are able to obtain an umpire.
- d) If a match is cancelled due to circumstances beyond the League's control, the fixture will be re-arranged to one of the reserve dates. However, should this not be possible, the re-arranged date will be mutually acceptable to both teams. Should neither team agree, the committee will stipulate a date, time and venue on which the match MUST take place.

Note:- Courts and facilities will be booked in advance on a block-booking basis by the Fixtures Secretary. All players are responsible for their own entry fee and parking at Sports Centres where applicable.

2. a) All clubs/teams competing must be registered and affiliated to England Netball (EN) and West Yorkshire County Netball Association (WYCNA) prior to the first match of the season.
- b) All individual players must be affiliated to EN and WYCNA prior to playing their first match of the season.
- c) All teams entering the WYCNA League must fully complete the league registration form and forward to the relevant Results Secretary before any player can take the court. Should there be any changes, the registration form must be updated and resent to the relevant Results Secretary prior to the player taking the court.
- d) Any player affiliated to WYCNA may only be registered to one team within the West Yorkshire League at any time.

- e) Should a player wish to change clubs during the course of the season, it is the player's responsibility to send an email to the secretaries of the clubs involved, copying the generic WY committee email (wycnacommittee@outlook.com). Only one change is allowed per season.

Note:- An upto date record, accessible to all results secretaries to be maintained by the Secretary Assistant

- f) If a club has more than one team in the same division, the team with the lowest allocated team number is deemed to be the highest positioned team, irrelevant of the team name.
*Example:- Portland Sports A = Team No 39 Portland Sports B = Team No 33
Portland Sports B will be deemed to be the highest positioned team*
- g) Movement of players within a club from a higher positioned team to a lower positioned one is not allowed except in exceptional circumstances (eg return from serious injury) and only by prior agreement with the WYCNA League Committee.
- h) If a player participates in 16 quarters with a higher positioned team, she becomes automatically registered with a higher positioned team of her club's choice and can not play for any other team within her club for the remainder of the season.

Note:- Rule 2c applies and a new registration form must be sent to the relevant Results Secretary Any infringement of Rule 2 will result in a void/cancelled match.

3. All teams applying to join the League will be placed in a division appropriate to their level of playing ability at the discretion of the League Committee after consultation with the County Committee.

Note:- It is intended that each division should consist of 10 teams however, the WYCNA League Committee reserves the right to alter divisions according to its needs. Team numbers per division to be agreed at 1st committee meeting when applications have all been received. The number of teams in each division for the 2019/2020 season will be as follows:-

<i>Super League</i>	<i>10</i>
<i>Premier Division</i>	<i>10</i>
<i>First Division</i>	<i>9</i>
<i>Second Division</i>	<i>10</i>
<i>Third Division</i>	<i>10</i>
<i>Fourth Division</i>	<i>10</i>
<i>Fifth Division</i>	<i>11</i>





4. a) At the end of the game, both score sheets should be completed, agreed and signed by the captains and umpires.
- b) Each team may declare up to 12 players by completing a score sheet and must indicate which quarter they have participated in.
- c) For all clubs with more than one team in the WYCNA League, any team changes/substitutions involving players registered with a lower positioned team, must be recorded on the score sheet.

*Note:- Infringement of rule 4 will result in a **ONE** point deduction.*

5. Both teams should electronically inform the relevant Results Secretary using the score sheet provided, of the result of the match by the Friday following the fixture.

Note:- If the score sheet is not received within this time, no points and no "goals for" will be awarded for the game to which the offence relates. If the offending team loses the match with less than half score, there will be a one point deduction

6. a) To cover the cost of the facilities, all teams will pay a match fee that will be set by the WYCNA League Committee and that will ensure that the cost of facilities is met. This will be reviewed as required.

Note:- The match fee for 2019-2020 season is £26.00

- b) The match fee is payable in advance. The first payment is due at the pre-season meeting and payment for further matches must always be received by the Friday following a fixture.

*Note:- This can only be done on-line and should be cleared funds showing in the league account **ON** the Friday.*

- c) Monies not received into the correct bank account, will be deemed as non-payment of fees and therefore this will result in no points, or "goals for" being awarded for the game.

- d) Cash is not accepted under any circumstances.

- e) All on-line payments must include the team name in full as listed in the handbook as the Reference. Bank details are:- West Yorkshire County Netball Association League Account
Sort Code 05-00-58 Account number 64208921

Note:- Any infringement of 6b) or 6c) will result in no points and no "goals for" being awarded for the Match. If the offending team loses the match with less than half score, there will be a one point deduction

7. It is intended that the times of the matches will be as follows:-

Game 1	09:00am - 10:15am
Game 2	10:15am - 11:30am
Game 3	11:30am - 12:45pm
Game 4	12:45pm - 2:00pm

Players and both umpires, are expected to take to the court at the specified time. Both umpires will signal the start of each quarter.

- a) Any team not on court and ready to play at the umpire's signal, will be required to pay the court costs and umpires' expenses for both teams, where these are incurred.
 - b) All matches will be of one hour's duration (4 x 15 minutes).
 - c) All matches must be played on the stipulated date and time and at the stated venue.
Note:- Any infringement of rule 7 will result in a void/cancelled match.
8. a) Any team claiming points for a void/cancelled match, must still submit a score sheet to the relevant Results Secretary clearly stating the reason for their claim and make the on-line payment as usual.
 - b) Points can only be awarded or removed by the League Committee once the claim has been investigated.
 - c) Any team claiming points for a void match but still using court time, ie: a 'friendly' game, must forward the match fee (non-refundable), along with a score sheet to the relevant Results Secretary, stating the reason for their claim.
 - d) They must also inform the opposing team of the reason for their claim, so that they have the right of reply if they disagree with the claim.





9. For all teams responsible for a void/cancelled match, a 3 point deduction will be applied per offence and the non-offending team will be awarded 3 points and 20 “goals for”.
10. a) Teams are responsible for providing their **own** suitably qualified umpires.
*Note:- Should you be using an umpire who isn't listed in the handbook, it is **YOUR** responsibility to provide evidence of the umpires' qualification either prior to the fixture or by the Friday following the fixture.*
- b) All matches will be umpired by two umpires, who must be affiliated to EN, and be aware of the WYCNA League rules.
- c) All teams in the Super League and Premier Division must name at least one 'A' or 'B' award umpire.
- d) All teams in Divisions 1 - 4 must name at least one 'C' award umpire.
- e) All Super League and Premier Division matches must be umpired by at least 'B' Award Umpires.
- f) All Division 1 – 4 matches must be umpired by at least 'C' Award umpires.
- g) The Fifth Division can be umpired by unqualified umpires but only when a fixture involves 2 unqualified teams. When a team with a qualified umpire is involved, the match must be umpired by two umpires with at least 'C' Award.
Note:- Any infringement of rule 10 will result in the fixture being void. All umpires named in the League Handbook should make themselves available to umpire WYCNA League matches.

11. All teams in the Super League and Premier Division are responsible for providing their own scorer who should stand together whilst scoring.

12. Umpires must not act as substitutes and, except in the case of illness or injury, shall remain the same throughout the match. If, whilst at the venue and on the original stipulated fixture date, the umpire is taken ill or injured and there is no substitute umpire available, the match will be abandoned and re-arranged by the Fixtures Secretary. The rearranged date will be mutually acceptable to both teams. However, should neither team agree, the committee will stipulate a date, time and venue on which the match **MUST** take place.
Note:- All umpires are expected to be suitably attired and wear neutral colours wherever possible.

13. Umpires and players, must not be involved in more than two WYCNA League matches in any one day either as a player or as an umpire, except at the discretion of the committee.
Note:- Any infringement of rule 13 may result in action being taken resulting in either the team/umpire or both, receiving a points deduction, ban or fine.

14. The 2 teams with the highest number of points in each division at the end of the season, will have the option of receiving league trophies, 2 new netballs or netball vouchers/cash. In case of a tie on points, the league position will be decided on goal difference.

15. Points will be awarded as follows:

Win	=	3 points
Draw	=	2 points
Loss (with half winning score or more)	=	1 point
Loss (with less than half winning score)	=	0 points

16. Automatic promotion and relegation of teams at the end of the season will normally be as follows:

Super League	- two teams relegated
Premier & Divisions 1-4	- two teams promoted
	- two teams relegated
Fifth Division	- two teams promoted

After automatic promotion & relegation a play off will take place, generally between the team finishing third from bottom and the team finishing third from top of the division below, the winner of the play off being placed in the higher division, subject to rule 10 c) & d) being satisfied.

Note:- Teams in a promotion position, can only be promoted if they have at least one suitably qualified umpire named with their team before the start of the new season.





17. a) The "play-offs" will take place on a date that will be set at the beginning of the season, with facilities and umpires being organised by the WYCNA League Committee. All matches will be of one hour's duration (4 x 15 mins). If, at the end of this period, the scores are equal, a further 2 minutes eachway (straight turnaround) will be played. If, at the end of the second 2 minute period the scores still remain the same, play will continue until a goal is scored.
- b) To be eligible to play in the 'play offs' all players must have participated in at least two games for that, or a lower position team within their club during the season.
18. Your attention is drawn to the following EN rules:
- a) No item of jewellery, except a wedding ring and/or medical alert bracelet, shall be worn. If either or both are worn, each shall be taped.
- b) Fingernails will be cut short and smooth. Taped fingernails will not be allowed.
- c) Gloves should not be worn except on medical grounds, and then only on production of a medical certificate.
- d) Hair must be suitably tied back.
- e) All players in a team must wear matching and appropriate playing uniform at all matches.
- f) Playing initials, worn both front and back, shall be 150mm (6 inches).
19. Your attention is drawn to the following WYCNA League rules:
- a) The 1st named team for each fixture **MUST** ensure no clash of kit/colours and should provide and wear different coloured bibs if necessary.
- b) Players may not take part in any match beyond the 12th week of pregnancy.
- c) Umpires may not take part in any match beyond the 20th week of pregnancy, except at the discretion of the committee.
- d) Any player/umpire participating in any match whilst pregnant, do so at their own risk.
- e) Players must not chew gum while playing.
20. a) Any team or individual who wishes to submit a complaint about a breach of the league rules by any other team or individual, must do so in writing to any 2 current committee members within seven days of the alleged incident, **clearly stating that it is to be treated as an official complaint**.
- b) If the committee members deem the matter to be of a disciplinary nature then the matter will be referred to the County Disciplinary Secretary.
- Note:- If your complaint involves an umpire, this will probably be forwarded to the County and/or Regional committee*
21. Any team or individual who wishes to submit an appeal against an infringement penalty or committee decision, must do so in writing to any 2 current committee members within 14 days of receipt of the committee decision.
22. It is the responsibility of the club secretary to inform the League Secretary and other club secretaries within their own division, of any details different from those appearing in the Handbook.
23. a) Every **team** must be represented at the AGM.
- b) Every **club** must be represented at the pre-season meeting.
- Note:- Any team/club failing to send a representative as required above, will be fined £25.00 for each meeting not attended, which must be paid before the first WYCNA league fixture date of the next season.*
24. All umpires listed in the handbook and a playing representative (non-umpire) of all teams participating in the West Yorkshire League, should attend a rules forum when arranged by the County Umpiring Secretary.
- Note:- Any team/club failing to send a representative as required above, will be fined £25.00 for each meeting not attended, which must be paid before the first WYCNA league fixture date of the next season.*
25. Any matters not covered by the rules will be decided on by the WYCNA League Committee.
- Note:- Where information is requested "in writing" this can be either by letter or email*

- Ensure all of the basic details are completed correctly and accurately
- Make sure your report is objective (don't include personal opinions and keep it factual)

REPORTING THE INCIDENT

- Give some context to the incident;
- Where were you on the court when it happened?
- Where was the other umpire when the suspension was made
- Where was the ball and who had possession of the ball?
- Where was the incident on the court?
- What happened in the run up to the incident?
- Had the player been formally cautioned/warned prior to the suspension?
- What happened in the incident?
- Report only what you saw and heard -these must be linked

CONCLUDING THE REPORT

- What were the outcomes you came to?
- How did you reach these outcomes?
- How was the game restarted?
- Were there any repercussions from the incident -only comment if there were
- The report must be emailed or posted to the relevant governing body/ league within 48 hours.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. How do we find an umpire?

A. All teams are responsible for finding their own umpire. There is a list of umpires in the back of this book, although you may use any qualified umpire who is affiliated to England Netball (EN).

Q. What do we do if we can't find an umpire?

A. Given time and patience ringing round will usually secure an umpire, as all teams must register an umpire (with the exception of teams from the unqualified division). If you can't find an umpire for your match, then you must drop a qualified player from your team, who can then umpire, even if this means playing with fewer than 7 players. If you are unable to do this, or your team does not have a suitably qualified player available on the day, then you will forfeit the points and may be required to cover court costs.

Q. Our umpire is unavailable for our match at short notice - What do I do?

A. We appreciate that this happens and is frustrating. However, it doesn't alter the League's rules and so it will still be your team's responsibility to either secure another umpire, or drop a qualified player to umpire. If you fail to do this, or your team doesn't have a suitably qualified player available on the day, then you will forfeit the points and may be required to cover court costs.

Q. What happens if our umpire doesn't arrive for our match, or arrives late?

A. Umpires are only human and though this happens only rarely, it is very frustrating! However, it doesn't alter the league's rules and it is still your team's responsibility to either secure another umpire, or drop a qualified player to umpire. If you fail to do this, or your team doesn't have a suitably qualified player available on the day, then you will forfeit the points and may be required to cover court costs.

Q. Can the League arrange an umpire for my match?

A. No, unfortunately not. We know that ringing round isn't a fun way to spend an evening but League committee members are all unpaid volunteers, with no more time to arrange umpires than team members.

Q. What do we do if we can't get a scorer?

A. At the moment, it is only a recommendation that all teams in the Super and Premier divisions provide a scorer. Therefore, if you are unable to provide one, you need to advise the umpires prior to the start of the game.

Q. Who can be a scorer and what should they do?

A. A scorer can be an independent spectator or a member of the squad. If a member of the squad is used, the position of scorer can be undertaken by any off court member. The scorer may change at quarter/half time as required. Both scorers should stand together in a position indicated by the umpires.

Q. What do we do if we need to cancel a match?

A. You need to inform the fixtures secretary and the opposing club secretary as soon as possible by phone and follow this up in writing, even if you cancel at short notice. As the court will still need to be paid for, you need to make an on-line payment for £52 and send your score sheet electronically, clearly stating that the fixture was cancelled by your team. If you cancel at very short notice and your opposition is unable to contact their umpire to inform them not to travel, you may also be asked to cover their umpiring costs.

Q. The opposing team has called to tell me they are cancelling our match - what do I need to do?

A. Contact the fixtures secretary to confirm that she is aware that the match has been cancelled and send your score sheet electronically, clearly stating that the opposition cancelled the fixture. Please make the match fee payment as usual, although this will probably be refunded at a later date, once the league has recovered the costs from the opposition.

Q. My team cancelled a match – why does it cost so much?

A. Once the courts have been booked they need to be paid for, regardless of whether a match has taken place or not and the fairest arrangement is for the cancelling team to stand this cost. In addition, it is unfair for a team to be expected to pay for their umpire, if they were not responsible for a game being cancelled. However, umpiring charges will only be applied where these were incurred by the opposition.

Q. Can I choose to re-arrange a match?

A. No - once fixtures are announced, these are fixed and teams are not permitted to re-arrange. This is to ensure that the League can keep track of which matches have and have not been played. Matches can only be re-arranged by the League committee at their own discretion and only in exceptional circumstances.

Q. What if the team we are playing cancels a match, arrives late or fails to turn up - can we claim the points?

A. Always send your score sheet and make your on-line payment within the usual timeframe, stating what happened and requesting a refund. Your match fee will be refunded once the league has recovered these from the opposition. You can claim the points for the match but don't assume that this will happen automatically. The committee will review each case and award and remove points as appropriate.

Q. What do I do if my game is abandoned?

A. Both teams should make their on-line payment and indicate on their score sheet, the reasons for the abandonment, the time remaining, the score and any other relevant information, including comments from the umpires which will enable the committee to review the situation.



- Q. What do I do if I think that weather conditions (ie snow) may cause my game to be abandoned?**
A. Should the committee decide to cancel fixtures due to weather conditions it will be posted on the website - www.netballwestyorkshire.co.uk, so always check before calling individual committee members.
- Q. What if I have any other questions about fixtures?**
A. Please contact the fixtures secretary who's contact details are at the front of this handbook.
- Q. How do I inform the league of results and pay our match fees?**
A. Club secretaries are issued with score sheets which must be completed after each fixture and sent electronically to the results secretary for your division and, as all matches are paid for in advance, you must also make your on-line payment to cover your next game. Both the score sheet and payment must be received by the Friday after your game.
- Q. How do I complete the score sheet?**
A. Each section of the sheet has a "title" which indicates the information that should be provided in that box. Example:- Date means that you put the date of the fixture, Squad means that you provide the names of the members of the squad for that fixture, Usual Team means you indicate the team that the member is currently registered with and Quarter 1st, 2nd, 3rd 4th means you tick to indicate if that person participated in that quarter.
- Q. What if our score sheet or payment is late or incorrect?**
A. The League can't function if it can't cover its costs and keep track of results. Therefore, prompt and accurate payments and results notifications are essential. If payments or score sheets are late or incorrect this may result in no points or goals for being awarded to your team.
- Q. I forgot to send our score sheet and payment - I've never done this before. Please can you make an exception, and award us our points?**
A. No - the League is often asked to make exceptions for cases like this and, whilst we sympathise and understand that mistakes do happen, the League can't function if it can't cover its costs and keep track of results, so prompt and accurate payments and results notifications are essential.
- Q. How do we register a new player to our team?**
A. You must affiliate the player with England and West Yorkshire Netball, update your team registration form and email the updated spreadsheet to the results secretary for your division, prior to the new player participating in any of your fixtures.
- Q. I'm part of a club and have played 16 quarters for higher positioned teams than the one I am registered with – what do I do?**
A. Any player in a club with 2 or more teams, must move to a nominated higher positioned team and remain in that team for the rest of the season. The nominated team is the choice of the club that she represents and must be advised to all relevant result secretaries as soon as she has participated in 16 quarters. Example:- A club has 3 teams and the player was originally registered as part of the 3rd team. She participates in 7 quarters for the 1st team and 9 quarters for the 2nd team. At this point the club MUST nominate whether she is a member of the 1st or 2nd team and she can no longer participate for any other team within the club, as she has used up her 16 quarters playing for a higher positioned team and movement to a lower positioned team is not allowed unless in exceptional circumstances and only by prior agreement with the WYCNA League Committee - rule 2g). Whichever team the player plays her 17th quarter for, is deemed to be her club nominated team.
- Q. What happens to a player who is sent off?**
A. They must stand with the scorers, be excluded from play and have no communication with their bench / team or officials until the controlling umpire allows them to return to court during any dead ball (i.e. ball out of play, penalty, infringement, goal scored, etc) following time being served. After the game the umpire who sent the player off, must ensure the team record the full name, and the umpire's reasons for the sending off before signing the team sheet. This will be collated and recorded by the league secretary and reported to the disciplinary team.
- Q. Where can I find information about umpiring and coaching courses?**
A. Either visit our website - www.netballwestyorkshire.co.uk or details may also be obtained from the County Coaching and Umpiring Representative respectively – See the Useful Contacts section of this handbook.
- Q. How can I get involved with the running of the league?**
A. The Committee always welcomes new people on board. You don't need any special skills, just an interest in keeping netball alive!! If you would like to help in any way, please contact the League Chair or Secretary.
- Q. How can I get a new copy of the League Handbook?**
A. Every affiliated member of the WYCNA will receive a League Handbook but if you need further copies, these may be obtained from the League Secretary at a cost of £3.00 each.
- Q. I've got a question that isn't covered elsewhere in this section - who can help?**
A. Please refer your question to the committee member whose role most closely relates to your question. For instance, questions about League finances are best addressed to the Treasurer. Failing that, any Committee member will be happy to help.

The written permission and age banding reference must be submitted to the relevant results secretary prior to that player participating in the league.
